

Study English

Students can study English for their own personal or professional goals. IELI students are considered University of Texas at Tyler students with access to all university services and facilities, like the library, health center, and university center.

Study to Work Towards a Degree

IELI students who want to study for a bachelor's, master's, or doctorate degree must apply to the university for admission into a degree program. Admission to UT Tyler requires a minimum TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score of 79, IELTS (International English Language Testing System) score of 6.5 and 6 or greater in all sub-sections, or PTE (Pearson Test of English) score of 53. The IELI will prepare students for university life and build a foundation in the English language that will help them succeed.

Waiver for UT Tyler Admissions

TOEFL, PTE, and IELTS scores will be waived for individuals who complete Level 6 of the University of Texas at Tyler Intensive English Language Institute (IELI) with all A's or those who complete Level 7 with B's and higher.

Housing

Housing is available for IELI students on and off campus. Residents are not required to live on campus, but the option is open if it is needed.

Intensive English Language Institute

UT Tyler's *Intensive English Language Institute* leads non-native English speakers in improving their academic English language skills and American culture knowledge.

U.S. Residents have *flexible options* to select and attend classes based on their individual language learning needs.

Sessions are 8-weeks long, allowing for 5 entry points each year.

Workshops and seminars are available throughout the year to allow students to have TOEFL and IELTS test practice with a qualified guide.

Admission to IELI

The IELI can accept anyone who is a non-native speaker of English and is at least 18 years old.

Placement in English Classes

New students are placed in classes based on their English proficiency test scores. At the end of the term, students move to a higher level based on in-class unit and achievement tests and end-of-course exams.

Short-term Programs and Seminars

The IELI conducts seminars and workshops on topics that vary across popular themes such as Healthcare, Business, Engineering, Pronunciation, TOEFL Prep, IELTS Prep, and Reading Improvement, among others.

IELI Application and Administrative Fees There is a preliminary, one-time application fee of \$130 (\$30 document processing fee and \$100 tuition deposit) which is non-refundable. Each session has an IELI fee charge to cover records processing.

Tuition Fees include placement testing, orientation program, desired number of class hours each week, social activities, practice TOEFL Examinations for students in good standing, transcripts and enrollment certification, basic computer access, and advising.

Book Fees There is a textbook fee for each class. Textbooks include a code for online access.
