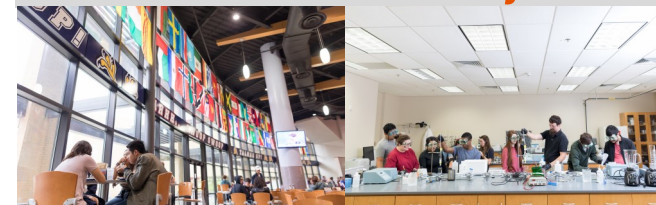
Diverse faculty are scholars in their fields of study and work closely with students in small classes.

Intensive English Language Institute

Admission to UT Tyler requires a minimum Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score of 79, International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score of 6.5 and 6 or greater in all sub-sections, or Pearson Test of English (PTE) score of 53.

UT Tyler's Intensive English Language Institute (IELI) assists non-native English speakers in improving their academic English language and American culture skills for successful university admittance. Consisting of 7 levels of instruction organized into two 8-week sessions each semester, and one 8-week summer session, the program includes Listening & Speaking; Grammar; Reading & Discussion; Writing, Editing & Research; Entry Level American Classroom Culture; and Advanced Level University Preparation, including Texas Success Initiative (TSI) training, in levels 5-7. Optional seminars* offered include TOEFL, PTE, and IELTS preparation and English Language Development (ELD) classes focusing on conversation, pronunciation, and grammar. Specialty seminars* offered: English for Business, English for Engineering, Tourism, and English for Health Care Professionals.

UT Tyler and IELI Accreditation

The Intensive English Language Institute is accredited through UT Tyler (SACS COC) and is SEVP-Certified.

TOEFL, PTE, and IELTS scores will be waived for undergraduate students who apply for admission to UT Tyler after completion of Level 6 of the UT Tyler IELI with final grades of A or complete Level 7 with final grades of B and higher.

*Weekly rates will be charged for short-term experiences, available for individual students or delegations. Personal expenses estimated at \$100/week.

*Must be accepted to a program by 1 May.
*SAT/ACT scores only valid within 5 years of testing.

*All transfer scholarships require the incoming transfer student to have 30+ hours from a 4 year institution or 45+ hours from a community college.

*All students that receive scholarships of \$1,000 or more per academic year (August-July) are eligible to receive in-state tuition.

International Graduate Scholarships

The New Graduate Fellowship

\$1,000 Awards are available for domestic and international, Texas and non-Texas residents. With this award, non-Texas residents also qualify for in-state tuition during their first year of graduate study only, which will also qualify for in-state tuition rates, reducing the estimated cost of tuition and fees for one academic year.

Minimum Qualifications

- Be accepted to a graduate, degree-seeking program
- Be in your first semester of graduate school at UT Tyler.
- Enroll full-time (9 credit hours for the semester awarded).

Meet or exceed at least one of the following criteria:

- Final undergraduate GPA of at least 3.25 (international transcript evaluation required)
- Final GPA of at least 3.25 on a prior master's degree
- Combined GRE score of 307
- Total GMAT score of 500
- Total MAT score of 410

*Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee an award. If you are not admitted to a program by 1 May, you will not qualify for the award. The New Graduate Fellowship only covers the first year. Second year students should speak with their advisor for available scholarships.
